ABOUT THE ARTWORK

***Medicinal Plants* emerged from a personal reconnection to nature after Emérence de Potesta relocated to Mallorca in 2022, following a decade between Brussels and London and the transformative experience of becoming a mother.**

Surrounded by wild herbs, citrus trees and aromatic shrubs, she began noticing how medicinal plants grow quietly and abundantly across the island, often overlooked, yet deeply potent. The painting draws from these species, weaving cultivated lemons together with untamed flora and so-called “invasive” companions.

The composition reflects an inner duality: animal and divine, chaos and clarity. Rather than resolving this tension, the work invites the viewer to inhabit it, recognising that healing does not occur in spite of disorder, but through it.

At its core, *Medicinal Plants* is both a personal meditation and an offering, a garden intended to bring calm, beauty and quiet reflection into lived and sacred spaces.

TWO INTERPRETATIONS, ONE STORY

Medicinal Plants is available in two distinct variations.

The BOTANICAL EDITION

focuses purely on the plant world; a refined, immersive landscape of medicinal herbs, cultivated greens and citrus. It offers a calm, architectural composition rooted in texture, tone and subtle movement.

The LIVING GARDEN EDITION

introduces the quiet presence of wildlife woven into the garden; a hare, birds, and other “invasive” companions that gently disrupt the cultivated order. This interpretation leans toward narrative and playfulness, speaking gently to mothers and young children.

PERSONALISATION

Each piece may be further adapted upon request.

Bespoke modifications are quoted individually.

The integration of a beloved pet within the landscape

Subtle colour adjustments to harmonise with an interior


The removal or addition of specific botanical or animal elements

WALLPAPER EDITION

Large-Scale Architectural Surface

Medicinal Plants is available as a made-to-measure wallpaper installation, printed on premium 173gsm non-woven paper.

The artwork was originally composed at mural scale, measuring approximately 2.2 m high x 2 m wide per full composition. It may be scaled proportionally to suit your space, depending on the desired impact. The design has also been adapted into a seamless large-scale repeat, allowing it to extend naturally across walls exceeding two metres without losing depth or balance.

Given the richness of the composition, this wallpaper is best approached as a mural, ideally placed on a feature wall, within an alcove or in a more intimate setting. Each installation is composed in response to your architectural context and dimensions. Emérence personally advises on placement and scale to ensure a result that feels intentional and balanced.



TEXTILE INSTALLATION

Soft Architectural Wall Art

Medicinal Plants may also be realised as a textile installation, a softer interpretation of the original composition.

Printed on heavyweight organic cotton canvas (309 gsm), the fabric introduces warmth, texture and gentle movement. The natural weave enhances the painterly quality of the artwork, allowing colour and detail to feel rich yet organic. This edition lends itself to statement panels, suspended compositions or refined framed textiles, offering a more intimate spatial presence than wallpaper.

Scale, proportion and finishing details are developed in dialogue with Emérence, ensuring the final piece feels balanced and intentional within its setting.

Organic cotton canvas (309 gsm) is used as the standard base material for textile installations. Other solutions can be sourced and specified on a bespoke basis, depending on the requirements.


INSTALLATION & FINISHING

Each installation is developed and coordinated by Emérence, with suspension, finishing and hardware tailored to the final composition.




SPATIAL CONFIGURATION

Suspension and finishing details are specified individually.



Maximum continuous fabric width: 150 cm. Height tailored per project. Available in vertical or horizontal orientation, option to join multiple panels for extended compositions.





FINE ART EDITIONS

Museum Paper & Canvas

Medicinal Plants is available as a fine art edition, produced either on textured 310 gsm museum-quality paper or as an archival canvas print. Both formats preserve the painterly detail, tonal subtlety and depth of the original work. Standard paper editions accommodate prints up to approximately 70 × 100 cm per panel and may be formatted as a single statement piece, diptych or triptych.

For larger dimensions or architectural-scale compositions, canvas is recommended and may be produced to custom proportions.

INSTALLATION & FINISHING

Framing and presentation are curated in consultation with Emérence, including decisions regarding negative space, mount proportion, frame material and finish. Options range from natural wood tones to black or gilded frames, ensuring the final presentation feels balanced and architectural.

Canvas works may be stretched, framed or mounted according to project requirements. Each edition is prepared and coordinated from production through to framing and delivery.



WOOD-FRAMED PANELS

Textile & Paper Art in Architectural Form

A bespoke collaboration between illustration and woodwork, these framed panels transform the artwork into a structured architectural statement. Each piece is custom-produced following consultation, combining printed artwork with handcrafted wooden framing. The result is a composition that feels both artistic and grounded.

A mural contained. A painting expanded.

Scale, framing proportion, wood tone and artwork placement are developed per project to ensure harmony with the space. Emérence personally oversees the creative direction and composition.

POSSIBLE APPLICATIONS

- Sliding wardrobe or door panels
- Fixed wall-mounted framed panels
- Freestanding folding screens (two, three or more leaves)
- Custom architectural inserts
- Panels may be produced as a single statement piece or as a continuous composition across multiple frames.

MATERIALS & CRAFTSMENSHIP

- Solid wood or veneered frames
- Natural finishes in oak, walnut, or custom stain
- Textile or fine art paper inserts
- Optional protective glazing
- Each piece is made to order in collaboration with skilled craftsmen.

THE LIVING GARDEN *Edition* introduces a quiet narrative presence within the landscape. Hares, birds and other companions emerge gently from the foliage, softening structure with instinct and story.

Designed with mothers, children and shared spaces in mind, this interpretation brings warmth and imagination into nurseries, bedrooms and family interiors.

All applications presented throughout this book — wallpaper, textile installation, fine art print, canvas and architectural wood-framed panels — are equally available in this variation.

ABOUT THE ARTIST

Emérence de Potesta is a Belgian–American artist based in Mallorca, working at the intersection of fine art, immersive interiors and refined event stationery.

Trained in architecture and visual arts, her early career centred on high-end decorative commissions and bespoke stationery for destination events. Known for her painterly detail and sensitivity to composition, she developed a practice rooted in precision, material awareness and narrative atmosphere. Over time, this foundation expanded beyond paper into large-scale painted environments that blur the boundary between artwork and architecture.

Drawing from the Mediterranean landscape that surrounds her, Emérence layers botanical forms with movement and permeability, allowing gardens to feel at once cultivated and untamed. Her compositions explore the quiet tension between structure and instinct, refinement and wildness; an interplay that mirrors both the natural world and the human experience.

Her series *Medicinal Plants* emerged from an exploration of inner duality: the coexistence of the controlled and the organic, the rational and the intuitive. In these works, flora and fauna weave through structured compositions, gently unsettling them. Rather than resolving the tension, the paintings invite the viewer to inhabit it.

At the core of her practice lies a belief that art can act as a form of sanctuary; not as escape, but as integration. A space where wildness and clarity coexist. A place where beauty becomes both grounding and alive.
